<u>Knock You Out</u> (Commentary about emptiness in a relationship. Don't let it "Knock You Out"). *"It takes a lot of nothing To find something in the meaning of what everybody talks about It takes a lot of nothing To find something in the emptiness before it finds a way to knock you out"*

<u>Leave Real Slow</u> (When she decides it is time to move on, but you're not ready). "When you set your spirit free – My arms may not release you But my heart will know what's right – and I'll let you go, I will let you go If you must go -If you must go"
